Such delegation includes, but is not limited to, conducting proceedings and hearings, issuing orders regarding claims of violation of K.S.A. 74-5616, and amendments thereto, deciding requests for reconsideration or requests for a stay, determining appeals or settlements, or any other matters related thereto unless the Hearing Committee in the cases enumerated above determines the matter should be considered by the full Commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bauer and passed unanimously.
