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**SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION**

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above-captioned matter comes on for Commission action through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, regarding the law enforcement certification of JESSICA LAVALLEY (Respondent).

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

1. The Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (Commission) granted full-time certification to Respondent, certification number 28395.
2. Respondent was employed as a full-time law enforcement officer with the Peabody Police Department (PPD) from October 29, 2025 to February 19, 2026.
3. In February of 2026, the PPD received reports from two law enforcement officers that Respondent had posted on Snapchat a photo of herself in front of a computer screen that clearly showed a PPD case narrative. The photo showed a juvenile's name, address, age, parent information, and image. As a result of the complaints, PPD opened an internal

investigation. During the internal investigation, Respondent acknowledged she posted the photo and resigned.

4. As a result, Commission Investigator Michael Oliver (Oliver) conducted an in-person interview of Respondent to determine her suitability for continued law enforcement certification. Oliver interviewed Respondent on April 14, 2026. Respondent acknowledged posting the photo, believing it to be blurry, and that she intended to post it to her “private” story, not her “public” story.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

#### Unprofessional Conduct

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(7), the Commission may revoke the certification of any police or law enforcement officer who has engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by rules and regulations of the Commission.
6. K.A.R. 106-2-3(d) defines unprofessional conduct as willfully disclosing criminal history record information or other information designated as confidential by statute or regulation, except for a legitimate law enforcement purpose or when required by court order of a court or agency of competent jurisdiction.
7. Respondent willfully disclosed confidential information in the photo she shared on Snapchat and such disclosure was not related to a legitimate law enforcement purpose.

#### Summary Proceedings

8. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to Respondent’s request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than Respondent.

**ORDER**

Based on the above Statement of Facts and Conclusions of Law, the Commission orders that the Kansas Law Enforcement Officer Certification of JESSICA LAVALLEY be revoked.

ACCORDINGLY, THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS' STANDARDS AND TRAINING CERTIFICATE OF JESSICA LAVALLEY IS HEREBY REVOKED.

FURTHER, Respondent is ordered to surrender and return to the Commission all evidence of her certification as a law enforcement officer.

**NOTICE OF RELIEF FROM THIS SUMMARY ORDER**

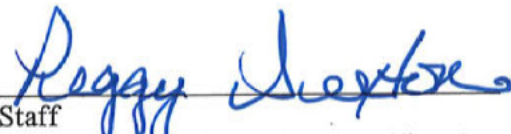
